Robert Wagner was swearn in. Members Arthur, Wagner, DeVries, McFarland and Lange answered aye to roll. Also present were Attorney Smoron and Clerk Miller

Public hearing to consider proposed changes to the zoning ordinance 5a-5-1 accessory buildings to provide for a maximum size of 144 square feet and a maximum height of 12 feet and an addition of 5a-5-6 which would restrict swimming pools to be located only in the rear yard of a lot in the e-1, r-1, r-2, r-4, r-5, r-6, r-7 and agricultural zoning districts subject to a minimum side yard setback of ten feet and a rear yard setback of three feet.

Public Hearing began at 6:36. Attorney Smoron that the changes to the Ordinance would be under accessory building and would have a maximum height of 12ft, a total square footage of of 144 sq. ft. There would be an addition for pools with the side set back being 10 ft. and the back setback would be 3 ft. All pools would be required to be in the rear yard. He then asked if anyone would like to speak. No one spoke.
