Village Board may hold a closed meeting to consider, among other items, the following under the Illinois Open Meetings Act: 1) the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the Village, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee to determine its validity; 2) collective negotiation matters between the Village and its employees or their representatives, or deliberation concerning salary schedules for one or more classes of employees; 3) the purchase or lease of real property for the use of the Village; including meetings held for the purpose of discussing whether a particular parcel should be acquired; and 4) litigation, when an action against, affecting or on behalf of the Village has been filed an pending before a court or administrative tribunal, or when the Village finds that an actions is probable or imminent, in which cause the basis for the finding shall be recorded and entered into the minutes of the closed meeting.
