DECEMBER 4, 2017

**Approve minutes of the November 20, 2017 Village Board Meeting**

**Discussion and vote to approve the Village Board Meeting Schedule for 2018**

Trustee Vole said he did not believe that the Village needed to have two meetings a month and pay the Trustees to be there. President Martinez explained that she believed they were need and that having only one made the meeting way to long. Trustee Shepherd said that he would agree to the schedule and if there was not much going on they could cancel a meeting. Trustee Lange made a motion to approve the schedule presented for 2018. Trustee Ritzert seconded the motion. Trustees Shepherd, Ritzert, Mogan and Lange approved the motion by answering aye. Trustee Vole voted nay. Motion carried.

**Discussion and vote on an ordinance removing a portion of 3-2-24C of the Village Code pertaining to underage drinking**

President Martinez explained to the Board that underage drinking at home with the parents was not allowed in Illinois. She also said if it was a religious ceremony exception it needed to happen at the place of worship. Trustee Ritzert asked what the fine would be and President Martinez said a minimum of \$500 and not to exceed \$2,500. Trustee Mogan said that that it was not against the law in Illinois for a parent to allow their child to drink in their home but could not serve other minors that were not their children. He felt that it was already a state law so there was no need to do this. There was no vote.
